

**NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY OF
ENGINEERING EVALUATION/COST ANALYSIS
(EE/CA) (DRAFT) FOR REMOVAL ACTION AT
DRMO MANANA STORAGE AREA
FLEET AND INDUSTRIAL SUPPLY CENTER,

The Navy has initiated a removal action in accordance with 40 CFR 300, the National Oil and Hazardous substances Pollution Contingency Plan (NCP), to cleanup arsenic and lead at the DRMO Manana Storage Area. An analysis of several removal alternatives were evaluated as part of an Engineering Evaluation/Cost Analysis (EE/CA). The EE/CA evaluates such factors as the cost, effectiveness, and implementability of each alternative. The proposed alternative will involve excavation and disposal of soil.
