The Navy has confirmed that petroleum product contamination exists in the soil and groundwater in the vicinity of the Public Works Center (PWC) Gas Station, Building 1326, Pearl Harbor, Hawaii. The administrative files, which include documentation of the environmental studies of this problem and the engineering evaluation/cost analysis (EE/CA) of the alternatives considered for the removal action, are available to interested agencies, individuals, and groups upon request. These files are located at Building 258, Pacific Division, Naval Facilities Engineering Command, Pearl Harbor, Hawaii. Agencies and the general public are also encouraged to provide written comments which should be mailed to the address below no later than December 16, 1991.
