

**NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY OF
ADMINISTRATIVE RECORD FILES FOR THE
POLYCHLORINATED BIPHENYL (PCB)
REMOVAL ACTION AT
NAVAL STATION, PEARL HARBOR**

The Navy Public Works Center, Pearl Harbor announces the availability for public review of the administrative record for the polychlorinated biphenyl (PCB) removal action at the Navy electrical substation D-01, Naval Station, Pearl Harbor. The substation is located within the Pearl Harbor Naval Station complex and is adjacent to Building 286, Armed Services Special Education Training Society School. The Navy has confirmed that elevated levels of PCB have been found in the soil adjacent to the electrical substation D-01. Appropriate action has been taken by the Navy to mitigate the threat to public health or the environment. The administrative files, which include documentation of environmental studies conducted and the subsequent removal action, are located at Public Affairs Office, Building A-4, Navy Public Works Center. Agencies and the general public are encouraged to provide written comments which should be mailed to the address below no later than February 28, 1992.
