

NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY OF ENGINEERING EVALUATION/COST ANALYSIS (EE/CA) and PLAN AND SPECIFICATION FOR REMOVAL ACTION (RA) NEAR BUILDING NO. 4, PEARL CITY JUNCTION (PCJ) FLEET AND INDUSTRIAL SUPPLY CENTER (FISC), PEARL HARBOR. The Navy has confirmed that deildrin contamination exist in the soil in the vicinity of Building 4, Pearl City Junction, Hawaii. Based on the Engineering Evaluation/Cost Analysis (EE/CA) recommendations, the Navy proposes to remove the deildrin contaminated soils from the site and dispose of it at an EPA approved disposal facility on the mainland. Copies of EE/CA, which briefly describes the removal alternatives analyzed by the Navy; and copies of Plan and Specification for the dieldrin removal will be available to interested agencies, individuals, and groups by September 13, 1993 at the Pearl City Public Library, 1138 Waimano Home Road, Pearl City, Hawaii; phone 455-4134.
