

Navy Petty Officer and Victims Identified

Navy Second Class Petty Officer David Allen De Armond, a Hull Technician (HT2), has been identified as the suspect currently being held in pre-trial confinement at the Navy Brig on Ford Island. The 32-year-old petty officer assigned to the Pearl Harbor Naval Shipyard turned himself in to the Navy Regional Security Office Monday morning.

Investigators and forensic specialists continue a thorough review and assessment of the crime scene at the residence in Hokulani Housing – a Navy Family Housing Area. Confirmation of notification of the next of kin was made late today.

The victims have been identified as 31-year-old Mrs. Zaleha De Armond and her mother, 75/76-year-old Saniah Binte Abdul Ghani, a citizen of Singapore.

The Naval Criminal Investigative Service is leading the investigation, with support from Navy Region security personnel.
