

Canadian Ship To Visit in Pearl Harbor

HMCS Calgary (FFH 335) will arrive in Pearl Harbor on Friday, Dec. 5 at 11:00 a.m. for a port visit. The ship has been participating in Operation Appollo, this was the Canadian contribution to Operation Enduring Freedom, the international coalition in the campaign against terrorism.

HMCS Calgary is a Canadian frigate that has been deployed for six months including three months of patrol duty and maritime interdiction operations in the Arabian Gulf. The ship and her crew of 30 officers and 182 are scheduled to return to their home port Esquimalt in Victoria, British Columbia, late next week.
