

Worker found dead at Pearl Harbor

PEARL HARBOR – A civilian contract worker was found unconscious by a fellow worker at the Bravo piers of Pearl Harbor Naval Station at 10:55 a.m. today. Passersby performed CPR until an ambulance arrived. The worker was taken to the Kapiolani Medical Center at Pali Momi where he was pronounced dead.

The death was due to an apparent heart attack.

The worker was employed by HSI-Mechanical, Inc., which is a subcontractor of Triton Marine Construction. Triton is contracted by the Navy to replace fuel lines under the Bravo piers.
